## THE ENGLISH ROYAL MACE

The replica of the Royal Mace of England was presented to the Commonwealth of Virginia in 1965 in the course of the 750th anniversary of Magna Carta. It was subsequently transferred from Jamestown Festival Park, where it was part of the anniversary exhibit, to the Marshall-Wythe School of Law. On ceremonial functions of the Law School, it is exhibited as a symbol of the continuity of the study of English constitutional and common law institutions in America's oldest law school, which will observe its own 200th anniversary in 1979.
