PISH KILL REPORTING

Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University reported, in a recent issue of Water News that persons aware of any fish kill in one of Virginia's streams should report the kill to the State Water Control Board's Pollution Response Program (PREP). The phone number is 804 786-2241 and is operational at all times. Persons who report a kill should give the location of the kill and, if possible, the number and kind of fish; whether they are dead or dying, and the condition of the water.
