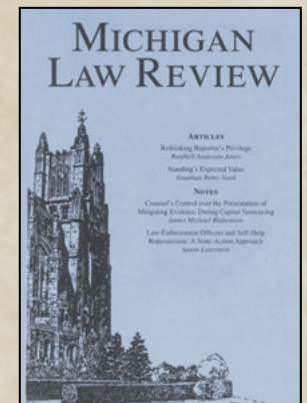
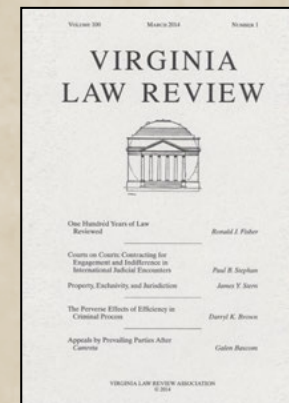

Founded in 1779 by Thomas Jefferson and George Wythe, William & Mary is the nation's oldest law school.

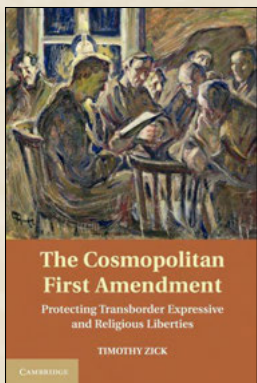
