An international negotiator examines the factors involved in slowing global warming in a manner that maximizes environmental benefits, fosters international security, creates a level playing field in international trade and suggests principles to incorporate in a new balanced international agreement to deal with climate change.

I. L. "Pep" Fuller served his country for 44 years in the Marine Corps, the Foreign Service, the EPA, and the Executive Office of the President, Office of the U.S. Trade Representative. He represented the U.S. in international negotiations including; environmental and health provisions of the NAFTA; the Uruguay Trade Round that created the WTO; and environmental treaties banning the world's most dangerous chemicals and requiring prior notification and consent before shipping of hazardous chemicals to other countries. For these and other accomplishments the President awarded him the rank of Meritorious Senior Executive. He received his J.D. from the University of Virginia and his Masters in International and Comparative Law from Georgetown.
