We are looking forward to having you with us on Saturday, April 28, for the Law Day exercises at 2 p.m. in Phi Beta Kappa Memorial Hall, and the ceremony to lay the cornerstone of the new Marshall-Wythe School of Law building at 3:30 p.m. at the construction site on South Henry Street.

The map on the reverse side of this letter indicates the parking areas you should use at Phi Beta Kappa and at the construction site. No special parking pass is necessary.

Following the exercises at Phi Beta Kappa Memorial Hall, you will want to drive your car to the new Law School building on South Henry Street for the ceremony to lay the cornerstone. A reception will follow on the lawn of the National Center for State Courts, adjacent to the construction site, as indicated on the map.

In case of inclement weather, the cornerstone laying ceremony will follow Law Day exercises in Phi Beta Kappa Hall without interruption, and the reception will be held in Robert Andrews Hall, indicated on the map, so that it will not be necessary to go out-of-doors.
